CHILDREN'S ACTIVITY LEADER:

The Volunteer Activity Leaders work alongside the Indian children's hostel wardens to look after the children's well-being in general. It involves helping the children get ready in the morning, organising fun activities during their free time, helping them with their studies and spending quality time with them until bedtime.



As an Activity Leader, you will be attentive to any changes in the children's behaviour, identify the reasons behind it and try to improve their personal development by giving them care, love, and attention. You will also support the children who face specific challenges, at academic and psychological levels. Wardens ensure that the children who have health issues are referred to the Head of Healthcare.

The Activity Leader role is demanding but it allows you to create a special bond with the children. If you like to spend time with children, then this is the perfect volunteering opportunity for you!

Responsibilities:

- Look after the children and prepare fun activities during their free time
- Be attentive to the personal hygiene of each child and give support
- Refer the children with health issues to the healthcare professionals
- Make sure that the children follow the school's schedule
- Impress the importance of punctuality and diligence upon them
- Identify the children's needs and help them manage their emotions better
- Attend weekly meetings with other volunteers and the coordinator

VOLUNTEER I.T. TEACHER:

From introduction to basic computer use to more specific computing projects, your mission is to break the digital gap and allow the young generation to find and use online resources properly, to research and study on a computer, and for the older students to develop IT skills they will need in their future professional career.



You will also offer IT support as day-to-day troubleshooting is required on campus if you can.

VOLUNTEER HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONAL:

At KSV, our students' health and well-being is our priority. We use a range of treatments, including natural remedies, to boost their immune system and protect the children from diseases and infections. We believe that prevention is better than cure, so our hygiene standards on campus are strict.



Our Volunteer Healthcare Professionals monitor the children daily, they provide medical treatment and follow-up examinations to the children who need it, with the support of the school wardens. They keep the kids' medical files up-to-date, and they collect online information about potential risks, seasonal diseases and various

infections. The Volunteer HP also takes children to the hospital / dental practice in Dharwad when necessary.

Volunteers can also share their knowledge and passion for community projects by running workshops about general health, personal hygiene, and the human body.

Responsibilities:

- Monitor children's health at the "Bobo House" (our infirmary) twice a day
- Prepare and give treatments (iron, vitamins) to all children on a rolling basis
- Prescribe medication and treatments when necessary
- Keep the kids' medical files up to date on the Bobo PC
- Arrange hospital and dental visits
- Keep the "Bobo House" clean and tidy
